Notre Dame Parish has been asked to join the other Christian churches, which make up the Ministerial Association, to provide bag lunches to the needy. The Soup Kitchen at Living Faith Chapel serves lunch on Mondays, Wednesday and Fridays from September to June, but not during July and August. The Homeless Shelter, Miwasin Kikinaw, has stepped up to provide lunches throughout the summer, but they need help. Living Faith Chapel will provide lunches every Monday, and the Ministerial Association is arranging with the other Christian churches to cover Tuesdays from August 4<sup>th</sup> to Sept. 1<sup>st</sup>. Notre Dame Parish's turn is next Tuesday, August 4<sup>th</sup>. We have found some volunteers to purchase the supplies, make the bag lunches and serve them from the Soup Kitchen door of Living Faith Chapel. We are planning to serve 100 bag lunches consisting of sandwiches, fruit, bottled water, granola bars and a small bag of chips. What we are asking of you, is donations to help cover the cost. No donation is too small. You may place your donation in the basket provided on your way out today, or you may send an e-transfer to the church's email address found on the front of the Sunday bulletin. Thank you very much for your kindness.
